## 'Namma MLA' App to help residents report civic issues

**I**N an effort to improve grievance redressal and strengthen communication between residents and their elected representative, Ambattur MLA G. Balamurugan has launched a mobile application, *Namma MLA*, enabling people to directly report civic issues in their neighbourhoods.

The application, introduced recently, is designed to provide residents with a simple platform to register complaints related to civic infrastructure and public services. According to the MLA, the initiative aims to ensure that complaints are received promptly, verified and taken up with the concerned authorities for early resolution.

Announcing this, he said, through the app, residents can upload photographs of civic problems, provide the location of the issue and submit details of their complaint. The application covers a range of public grievances, including damaged roads, drinking water shortages, sewage stagnation, garbage accumulation, non-

functional streetlights and other issues affecting daily life.

The MLA said the initiative was intended to make grievance reporting more accessible while reducing the gap between the public and their elected representative. Instead of relying solely on conventional methods such as petitions or personal visits, residents can now register complaints digitally from their mobile phones.

According to the information released along with the launch, a dedicated team attached to the MLA's office will review the complaints received through the application. The team is expected to contact complainants within 48 hours after a grievance is registered to

gather additional details, if required, and facilitate follow-up action with the appropriate civic departments.

Balamurugan described the application as a "direct bridge" between the people of Ambattur and their MLA. He said the objective was not merely to receive complaints but to work towards finding timely solutions. "Your locality, your problem, our responsibility," the message accompanying the launch stated, underscoring the focus on responsive governance.

The app also seeks to encourage citizen participation by allowing residents to document local civic deficiencies with photographs, making it easier to communicate the nature of the problem to officials. Such digital documentation is expected to help prioritise issues and monitor follow-up action.

The *Namma MLA* application is now available for download on the Google Play Store. Residents can install the app and use it to report civic issues in their respective neighbourhoods.

## TN rolls out phase one of first digital Census

**T**AMIL NADU has rolled out the self-enumeration phase of Census 2027 from Friday, marking the State's participation in India's first fully digital population census and the first nationwide headcount exercise in 16 years.

Citizens can voluntarily submit their household particulars online from July 17-31, while door-to-door House Listing and Housing Census operations will be carried out between August 1 and 30.

The director of Census Operations, Tamil Nadu appealed to the public to participate in the exercise and extend full cooperation to field officials.

The households opting for self-enumeration could securely furnish their details through the online portal until July 31. The portal will remain accessible daily from 6 am to 12 midnight. The process is expected to take about 15 to

### SELF-ENUMERATE IN 9 STEPS

- Visit <https://se.census.gov.in> and select Tamil Nadu under States and enter the CAPTCHA
- Enter the name of the head of the household and a 10-digit mobile number (The name cannot be changed later; only one mobile number per household allowed)
- Select the preferred language and enter the One-Time Password received on the registered mobile number
- Select your district; enter PIN code and details of the town or village
- Pin your exact residential building on the map given
- Fill out the house listing and housing census questionnaire
- Verify all the information using the preview/review options (no changes/ corrections are allowed after final submission)
- After submission, an 11-digit Self-Enumeration Identification (SE ID) will be generated
- Share the SE ID with the Census Enumerator visiting the household

20 minutes. Once completed, the system will generate a unique self-enumeration ID, which residents must produce when enumerators visit their homes. Families that do not opt for self-enumeration will be covered during the regular door-to-door enumeration from August 1.

Addressing concerns over privacy and cybersecurity, a three-tier secu-

rity architecture had been built into mobile devices, applications and server networks to safeguard personal information. The citizens are asked not to use unofficial websites and advised to access only the authorised census portal to prevent fraud.

The first phase would collect detailed information through a schedule comprising 33 questions.

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## 'Movie-Style' abduction in locality shocks residents

RESIDENTS of Nolambur have expressed shock after a 39-year-old man was allegedly abducted in broad daylight, assaulted and pressured to transfer ownership of his house over an unpaid loan—an incident many said resembled scenes usually seen only in movies rather than in their otherwise peaceful neighbourhood.

The Nolambur Police have arrested two men in connection with the case and launched a search for the remaining accused.

According to the police, the victim, Priyadharshan (39), a resident of Brindavan Avenue in Nolambur, has been running a lodge since 2015. He had borrowed ₹22.5 lakh from an acquaintance, Senguttuvan, to construct the lodge. While he repaid ₹7.5 lakh, an outstanding amount of ₹15 lakh remained.

Police said that on May 29, Priyadharshan was standing near his residence

when three unidentified men approached him claiming that Senguttuvan wanted to meet him. The men allegedly forced him into a car and drove away, leaving residents in the area unaware of what had transpired.

Investigators said the victim was allegedly assaulted during the abduction before being taken to Senneerkuppam, where Senguttuvan allegedly demanded that Priyadharshan transfer ownership of his house instead of repaying the balance loan amount. The victim was allegedly confined in a private lodge in Senneerkuppam for some time before being taken to the Maduravoyal Bypass and abandoned there.

After securing his release, Priyadharshan approached the Nolambur Police and lodged a complaint detailing the sequence of events.

Based on the complaint, the police registered a case under various sections, including kidnapping, and launched an investigation. During the probe, police arrested two suspects, identified as Vignesh (34) and

Kamal (33), both residents of Senneerkuppam. Efforts are continuing to trace Senguttuvan and the other accused who are currently absconding.

The incident has left residents of Nolambur disturbed, with many saying they never imagined such a brazen abduction could occur in their locality. Several residents remarked that forcible kidnappings to settle financial disputes were inci-

dents they had watched only in crime thrillers and films, making the case all the more unsettling.

Locals hoped the police would ensure that such incidents do not recur.

Police sources said the investigation is focused on establishing the roles played by each accused, gathering evidence related to the alleged confinement and assault, and tracing the remaining suspects.

## Ageless Messi Inspires Argentina

LIONEL Messi has sizzled with his sublime skills in the on-going World Cup, co-hosted by USA, Mexico and Canada. Messi has become the highest goal scorer in World Cups (21 goals). The 39-year-old is also the joint highest goal scorer along with Kylian Mbappe (eight goals). Messi has inspired Argentina to the World Cup final for the second straight time. The defending World champion came back from a goal down to prevail over England 2-1 in their last-four clash in Atlanta, USA. Argentina will cross swords with Spain in the summit clash at the New York New Jersey Stadium on Sunday.

Messi, who has been dubbed as the GOAT by footballing experts, turned the high-octane match against England in Argentina's favour in the second half. Down 0-1 with less time remaining for the match to end, Messi made two assists to power Argentina to victory. Enzo Fer-

nandez (85th min) and Lautaro Martinez (92nd min) scored as the Argentine fans erupted in joy.

Argentina's fighting spirit came to the fore in this edition of the World Cup. Down 0-2 to Egypt and being on the brink of exiting the World Cup, Argentina made an incredible comeback to oust the former African champions 3-2 in their last-16 match. Cristian Romero (79th min), Messi (83) and Fernandez (82nd min) scored for the winners.

In the quarterfinals, Argentina edged Switzerland 3-1 in a close match, which went to extra time. Alexis MaCallister (10th), Julian Alvarez (112th) and Martinez (121st) scored for the winners.

Resilience and fighting spirit are the two qualities that has stood out in Argentina's performance this time. Messi has been the talisman but every Argentine player has contributed to the team's stirring show.

What has amazed footballing pundits was Messi's ability to perform at a high level at a not so young 39! Messi has played with passion and emotion. His dribbles, crosses and creativity in the six-yard box has wowed the fans all over the world.

Spain and Argentina have been the two best teams in the World Cup. Spain reached the final with a comprehensive 2-0 victory over France. Mikel Oyarzabal (22nd min) and Pedro Porro (58th min) were the goalscorers for Spain.

European champions Spain is one of the most attractive teams to watch because of their brand of football. One-touch pass (Tiki-Taka), accuracy and possession of the ball is what makes them a tough team to beat. Spain, who will be gunning for their second World Cup crown, has been on a 37-match unbeaten run (28 victories and nine draws), which was remarkable.

Tiny nation Cape Verde

(population of 5,00,000) made a mark, entering the last 32 of the World Cup on their debut.

## Gukesh Loses To Firouzja

World champion Dommaraju Gukesh went down to Alireza Firouzja in the second round of the Quantbox Chennai Grandmasters here on Friday. Fresh from his success in Zagreb, Firouzja leads with two points in the seven-round closed round-robin tournament.

Gukesh drew his first round against Nihal. The Indian will be looking to perform better in the remaining rounds. This tournament is the only high level classical tournament in India. This is one of the strongest tournaments with seven players having a rating above 2700. Gukesh (2023), Aravindh Chithambaram (2024) and Vincent Keymer (2025) are the three winners of the Chennai GM.

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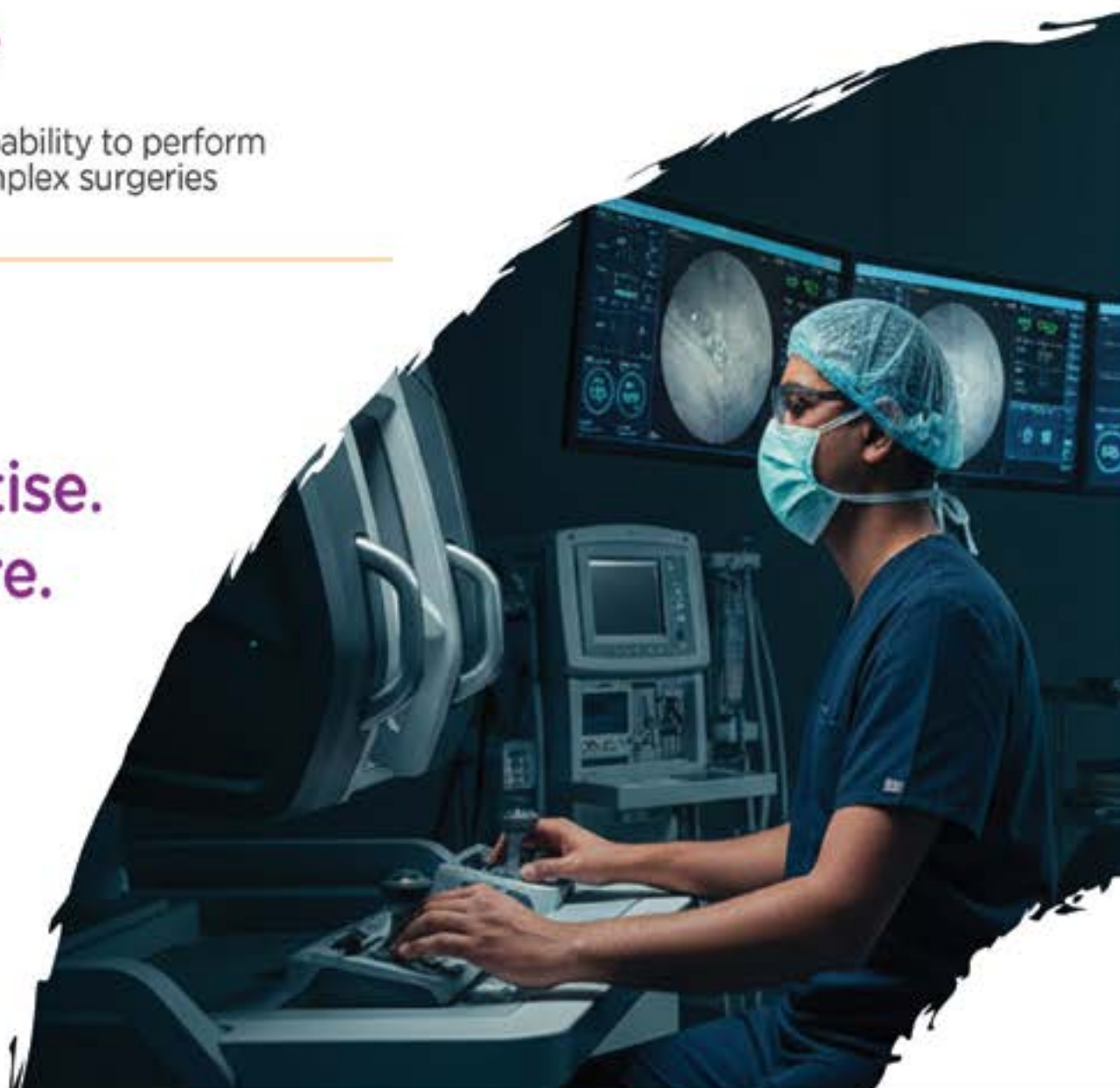


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## 'Immortal' release postponed to Sept 4

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## Residents welcome anti-littering board in Mogappair East

**R**ESIDENTS of Mogappair East have welcomed the Greater Chennai Corporation's (GCC) initiative to install an anti-littering notice board on Ori Salai but say the civic message must be backed by stricter enforcement at a nearby garbage dumping hotspot that continues to witness indiscriminate disposal of waste.

The blue signboard, recently installed by the Corporation's Ward 93 office, urges the public not to dump garbage in the area. The Tamil message warns that legal action will be initiated against those who violate the rules by dumping waste indiscriminately.

While appreciating the initiative, local residents pointed out the irony that garbage continue to be



dumped just a few metres away from the board. They said the stretch near the Original Salai-EB Road junction has become a regular dumping point despite repeated complaints.

A visit to the locality found piles of mixed waste, including, plastic, cardboard, dry leaves and other discarded materials lying along the roadside near a residential apartment complex. Residents alleged that

apart from household waste, debris from renovation works is also frequently dumped at the location.

"The Corporation has taken the right step by putting up this board. Such awareness measures are necessary. But unless similar warning boards are installed at the actual dumping spot and violators are penalised, the problem will continue," said a resident of the locality.



Another resident said garbage is often dumped during the night or early morning, making it difficult to identify those responsible. "The place gets cleaned occasionally, but within a day or two fresh waste appears again. It has become a recurring problem," the resident said.

Residents urged the civic body to install another warning board at the Original Salai-EB Road

junction, where illegal dumping is more prevalent. They also called for increased surveillance through CCTV cameras, regular monitoring by sanitary workers and strict fines against offenders.

According to them, a combination of awareness and enforcement would help keep the neighbourhood clean. "People should realise that roadsides are not dumping yards. If the

Corporation identifies and penalises those violating the rules, others will think twice before dumping waste," a resident observed.

The installation of the signboard has nevertheless been viewed as a positive beginning. Residents hope the initiative will be expanded to other vulnerable locations in Mogappair East where garbage dumping continues to be a persistent civic concern.

With illegal dumping affecting the cleanliness and appearance of residential neighbourhoods, residents say visible warning boards at identified hotspots, coupled with timely waste collection and enforcement of civic regulations, will go a long way in ensuring cleaner streets and greater public participation in maintaining sanitation.

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
